

Jaycee Founder, Henry Giessenbier, Jr., and 31 other young men met October 13, 1915, to form the Young Men's Progressive Civic Association at the old Mission Inn, pictured above, in St. Louis, Missouri. Five years later, the association became the U.S. Junior Chamber of Commerce. The Inn was razed in 1937 and a supermarket stands in its place today. On their 40th anniversary, the Jaycees return to the St. Louis birthplace for a national convention on June 20-24, 1960.


