70th CREW REUNION AT MYRTLE BEACH, SC MARCH 10-12 A SUCCESS THE WEEKEND, AS REPORTED BY MATE GEORGE FRASER II

What a great weekend! Under the leadership of Mates BOB LINDHOLM, Keeper of The Log, and KIM NEWLIN, Co-Keeper of The Log (Email/Roster) and their wonderful wives, LOIS and BEVERLY, another successful meeting of THE CREW was held. All of the Mates who have had the responsibility in the past for arranging for meetings and carrying out the minute details of program, reservations, and hospitality, can appreciate the effort our committee made. It was an excellent meeting!

Honorary Chairman MATE JEFF DAVIS led a spirited group of members of THE CREW and their guests, from the early muster in the Hospitality Suite on Thursday evening, through the Friday-Sunday scheduled program. His eyes may not be what they used to be, but his mouth and the eloquence that flows forth from it has not diminished over the years.

THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY AND 70TH REUNION informally began Thursday evening, a day early, when the Crew Hospitality Suite opened to accommodate the early arrivals, also providing a Continental Breakfast Friday AM. From that time on it was open all weekend to Mates and their guests, until about noon on Sunday; food and drink aplenty thanks in large part to this year's Hospitality Suite Sponsors, listed after this Reunion Report, and Hosts MATES KIM AND BOB, with wives and unsung heroes BEV AND LOIS. Lois also handled the Registration Table and did the posters and other signs. The Jaycees kindly caused Budweiser to donate 3 cases of beer to the Suite, which in the old days would have been consumed in a few hours. Instead, leftover beer was passed on to thirsty Jaycees when our suite closed late Saturday night.

SATURDAY MORNING'S HONOR'S BREAKFAST, honoring early Crew members, beginning in 1931, was hosted by our HONORARY CHAIRMAN MATE JEFF DAVIS, who introduced speaker MATE HAL SALFEN (TX) who spoke about some of the early leaders he knew during his Jaycee days. MATE HAL has written a book about his life including service in WWII and the Jaycees. That was followed by a spirited morning session consisting of two panels: "I remember John....", CREW founder, followed by "If I were President of the US Jaycees today.....". Current Jaycee President and MATE LISA PARRISH (VA) joined us to hear our suggestions, and rejoined us to speak at our Past President's Luncheon, along with Jaycee COB AND MATE DR. JULIE METZGER (KY).

Panel members for the morning sessions were: MATES GEORGE FRASER II (OR), MOTON CROCKETT II (TX), WAYNE FIELD (MN), JEFF DAVIS (GA), BILL ROBERTSON (FL), BOB GOETZ (VA), JIM WARREN (FL), ED HART (MO), ED TRAVOLO (Canada), EV WERNESS (VA), RAY NOXSEL (CA), JOE SOUZA (CA) AND A.J. MORTON (NC) and current USJCC President MATE LISA PARRISH.

By the way, MATES JOE SOZA and MOTON CROCKETT are currently serving as Trustees of the United States Jaycees Foundation.

Many MATES, responding to a request to send in remarks or suggestions for the morning sessions, did

so., and they were read by members of the panels. THE FIRST PANEL WAS "I REMEMBER JOHN...", and MATE JOHN'S daughter PRISCILLA ARMBRUSTER HOEL sent a wonderful letter that was read, detailing her recollections as a teenager when her father launched THE CREW, mentioning his service in the Navy during WWI, his nautical leanings being the basis for the naming of the SS Fellowship and THE CREW; MATE ROSS SMYTH (Canada) was to attend but couldn't, so ED TRAVOLO (Canada) read his remarks about the beginnings of the JCI Senate. BOB DUNBAR (MN) wrote about John's help in getting financing for the War Memorial Building in 1970, asking current EVP Bob at that time "Aren't you taking women yet?"; DAVE HAXTON (NC), out of the country and unable to attend sent a long letter about his friendship with JOHN AND MATE ANDY MUNGANAST, saying that both were ushers at his wedding; MATE DOUG FISHER, JCI Senator #330 (Canada), still recovering from a massive stroke in 2003 and a broken back in 2004, took time to send a large file which included three handwritten pages of notes about his friendship with MATE JOHN and MATE ANDY MUNGANAST, and the early Jaycee movement in the US and Canada, also enclosing a CD of speeches and interviews dating back to 1941 (The Keeper of The Log owes you a telephone call, MATE DOUG!)MATE BOB GANO(CA) Emailed that MATE JOHN personally encouraged him to join the Jaycees, then many years later, nominated him to Crew membership.

The SECOND PANEL MODERATED "WHAT YOU WOULD DO IF YOU WERE PRESIDENT", and suggestions came in from many MATES, a few of which follow: TOMMY THOMAS (TN), who has two daughters and two sons who are currently active Jaycees, sent in five suggestions and four ways to accomplish them. He would be full time, would live in Tulsa for his year, have the personal skills to handle it, and be committed to the success of the Jaycee Movement. Sound familiar?: DEWAYNE SUMNER (TN), a new MATE (NVP 1995) and also a 1st time Sponsor of our Hospitality Suite, said "We have a lot of young, excited Jaycees across America doing some awesome things. We may not be as big or as bad as we used to be, but we are still making some unbelievable things happen.; MATE AND PRESIDENT LISA joined us for most of the session's discussion's, listening to suggestions by our Mates, and thanking THE CREW for their input.

OUR PAST PRESIDENT'S LUNCHEON'S featured speakers were Current USJCC President MATE LISA PARRISH and Immediate Past President MATE DR. JULIE METZGER. MATE LISA told us of her plans for her year, also informing us that the current US Jaycee's membership is in the 44,000 range. MATE JULIE spoke of her accomplishments during her year at the helm, and how good it was to be back home working at her profession.

THE EVENINGS RECEPTION AND CREW AWARDS DINNER featured MATE JEFF DAVIS as our after dinner speaker, who related a number of colorful stories about his active Jaycee years in Georgia and US Jaycees politics. After dinner, as has been our custom for the past three years, we adjourned to special seating in the main ballroom for the formal US Jaycees Officer Installation ceremonies. After the new officers were sworn in and the new President spoke, we took our leave and adjourned to the popular Hospitality Suite, where food and drink and tall stories of yesteryear never seemed to run out.

SHIP'S CHAPLAIN, MATE DARYL WATTS led a wonderful FELLOWSHIP/PRAYER BREAKFAST PROGRAM SUNDAY MORNING, that began with MATES GEORGE FRASER and RAY NOXSEL reading prayers and scripture. Our featured speakers arranged by MATE TOM DONNELLY were ANN AND BUTLER BENNETT, National Prayer Breakfast (also known as the President's Prayer Breakfast) participants. They spoke about what has become their life's work as Christian Counselors, and the people from around the world that they have met in the process.

As the breakfast ended, I was reminded of the poem "FRIENDS FOREVER"

"What made us friends in the long ago when we first met? Well I think I know!

The best of me met the best of you, found each other because they knew,

That always and always since life began, our being friends was part of God's plan!"
