Mate KIM NEWLIN, who has done so much to grow our mailing and email lists in

the last five years, as well as helping at each Reunion, has volunteered to serve as Interim Keeper of The Log to coordinate and handle details, as he and the others on our "Engine Room" Team keep the SS FELLOWSHIP on course until such time as the 4th Keeper of The Log is chosen.

HERE IS HOW THE 4TH KEEPER OF THE LOG WILL BE SELECTED.

At the April 1978 Crew Reunion immediately following MATE JOHN ARMBRUSTER'S death, on a motion by MATE CHUCK SHEARER Past National President (IN) and seconded by MATE GEORGE PAGONIS Past national Vice President (NJ), a Continuing "Steerage" Committee was formed, to be made up of all living Past Crew Reunion Chairmen, whose sole purpose would be to make any MAJOR decisions that had to be made on behalf of THE CREW. It has rarely had to make any hard decisions in the last 30 years, but it will be put to use to help find and install the next permanent Keeper of The Log. In the interim, MATE KIM NEWLIN will coordinate things in the "Engine Room", and I will be around to help out.

"KEEPER OF THE LOG" HISTORY

MATE JOHN ARMBRUSTER, who officially launched THE CREW OF THE SS FELLOWSHIP with a letter of invitation 77 years ago, on June 26th, 1931, was the 1st Keeper of The Log and served in that position for 47 years until his death in February 1978on his way to a meeting at Jaycee Headquarters in Tulsa.

After MATE JOHN'S death, the US Jaycees continued the publication of the Log until 1996, when MATE RALPH ROHWEDER, a Past National Vice President from Chicago, took over as 2nd Keeper of The Log with MATE BOB GOETZ as his Co-Keeper. From that time on, we have been dependent on members of THE CREW for donations to print and mail THE LOG.

I took over from MATE RALPH with his health deteriorating in early 2003, and became the 3rd Keeper of The Log just weeks before his passing.

In the five years that I have been your KOTL, we have assembled a strong and loyal "Engine Room" team of Co-Keepers that will continue on with the 4th Keeper of The Log.

First of all, thanks to the exceptional efforts of Co-Keeper MATE KIM NEWLIN, we have grown our email list of Shipmates from 85 to just shy of 500, and our mailing list from under 800 to more than 1400, nearly 1000 of which may not have access to a computer and therefore depend on THE LOG to keep them connected with news of their Shipmates, and our Annual Reunions. Next, thanks to the generosity and skills of Co-Keeper and Historian MATE WAYNE FIELD, a "History Of The Crew 2004" was published and a copy given to all Mates that attended our 2004 Crew Reunion in Tulsa. Those who received or have since purchased a copy of what we call the "Blue Book", for short, will receive Addendums to the book as they are published before each Reunion, until a new "Blue Book" is printed. The cost is \$50 for the book and addendums with a check payable to "The Crew...History" sent to Co-Keeper MATE MARY SAWYER, 747 Oak Lane, Ballwin, MO 63021. She will send your "Blue Book" when she returns home at the end of June.

MATE MARY wants your Bio for the upcoming Addendum, DEADLINE JULY 1, if

you are not currently in "The Blue Book" and want to be included (no purchase is necessary), complete the form for that purpose available in this issue of THE LOG.

Thanks to Co-Keeper and MATE KEVIN KREPINEVICH we have a Website, USJCCCrew.org and he is our Webmaster. In addition to copies of old LOGS and other information, Mates are able to check their own data for correctness or search for a fellow Crew Member that they may have lost touch with. THE CREW OF THE SS FELLOWSHIP must continue on into the future to fulfill MATE JOHN'S dream of staying in contact with friendships formed in Jaycees. A portion of his June 26, 1931 reads....."This ship is supplied to us gratis. I will be glad to keep THE LOG - your pay will be the pleasure you derive from keeping in touch with your acquaintances and friends made in the JC affairs. Your duties will be to contribute your experiences and thoughts occasionally when the spirit moves you" /s/ Bob Lindholm

The 71st Crew "Come Home to St Louis" Reunion kicked off Friday night with our usual "Welcome Aboard Reception", hosted by MATE MARY SAWYER, Co Chair of the Reunion. Early Saturday Morning at the "Honors Breakfast", MATE MARY and Honorary Chairman MATE MIKE MILDER welcomed Mates to the breakfast. Our speaker was MATE BILL WEISS, who joined the Jaycees in 1931. He is a Past President of the St Louis Jaycees and was John Armbruster's personal attorney in those days. We then adjourned to two panel sessions: The 1st honoring MATES JOHN ARMBRUSTER AND ANDY MUNGANAST, where the Panel and and most present, talked about their association with MATE JOHN and MATE ANDY MUNGANAST, both being among the Founders of Junior Chamber International. The 2nd panel discussed things that they would do to improve the US Jaycees and JCI, with the current president of the US Jaycees in attendance. Next came the Past President's Luncheon, where Past President MATE CHRIS OLDHAM, MATE LISA PARRISH, current Jaycees COB, and MATE ROYCE PEPPIN (Australia), 1972 JCI World President, were the speakers. That afternoon, a Reunion highlight was a bus tour honoring of

I was impressed with HENRY GIESSENBIER'S grave monument, for it had the Jaycee Creed on the right side of it. Sunday morning's Prayer/Fellowship Breakfast was chaired by our Chaplain MATE DARYL WATTS, who also introduced our speaker MATE ANDY TOBIN, Past President of the US Jaycees 1988/89 and current Member of the Arizona House of Representatives, who spoke on a tenet of the Jaycee Creed, "Faith in God gives meaning and purpose to human life.

Our Losses

We have lost 99 Mates since last published, some who were not reported until years after their deaths. I have received information on some which I will mention briefly in addition to the list published below. First, **Mate Gerald Ford** who went on to hold the highest office in the Land, President of the US passed away December 26, 2006 and was from Grand Rapids MI but was living in Rancho Mirage, CA at the time of his death. Next, **Mate Bill Suttle** who was a Past President of the US Jaycees in 1966/67 and was originally from NC, passed away May 2, 2006 in Chapel Hill, NC. In addition we lost a Past World President of JCI, **Mate Jay Smith** who was from CA but living in UT at the time of his death 5/23/07. Next we had an unexpected loss of a Past President of the US JCI Senate, **Mate Tom Stone** from Carrolton Georgia on Feb 20, '07. In addition we lost **Mate Pete Baldwin** of Howell, MI on 8/24/07, Past President of the MI Jaycees and regular Crew attendee. **Mate JR (Pat) Gorman** was a regular CREW attendee and a past member of the Nixon Administration on 12/8/06, **Mate Gord Lowry** from Canada and regular CREW attendee on 7/1/07. **Mate James Cashman** from Las Vegas NV and past NVP of the US Jaycees and big CREW supporter passed away 12/7/05. **Mate Bill Harrison** from Indianapolis IN and Past EVP, US Jaycees passed away. **Mate Billy Harrison** from Rocky Mount NC and Past President of the NC Jaycees and big supporter of the CREW passed away 2/7/06 and whose son is President of Chase Bank. **Mate Ken Holvenstot** from Cedar Rapids IA and past Chaplin of the US Jaycees and CREW supporter passed away 12/3/07. **Mate Sloan McCrea** from Miami FL and Political Power Broker for over 4 decades who was a lifelong Democrat but befriended a Republican President, Mate Richard M. Nixon (and did his Eulogy at the Key Biscayne Presbyterian Church in Mar '94 which I attended) and helped get his childhood friend, Mate George Smathers elected to the US Senate died 2/22/08. **Mate George Smathers** from Miami FL who was the childhood friend of Mate Sloan McCrea above who helped elect him to the US Senate died 1/20/07. **Mate Ken Shirk** from Akron/Lancaster PA and past Parliamentarian, attorney and CREW supporter died 1/19/06, **Mate Jack Morton** originally from Washington DC Chapter and a Past National Director of the District of Columbia and big CREW supporter in the early years. **Mate Jack** was an event industry legend who pioneered using headline Entertainers at conventions and corporate events, died June 28, 2004 at his home in Vero Beach FL at the age of 94. His son Bill tells us his father often reminded him that a "good name" is the most important treasure any human being may earn. **Mate JL McMullen**, Our Honorary Chairman for the 2005 CREW Reunion that was held in Daytona Beach, FL passed away the week of the 2007 CREW Reunion in St Louis MO. He is a past President of the Florida Jaycees and was the youngest Clerk of Court in the US when he was appointed at the age of 18. Although bound to his wheel chair from MD, this never deterred him from accomplishing his dreams. I visited him after the 2006 CREW Reunion in Myrtle Beach SC and he showed me articles where the Live Oak Jaycees used to run welcome station for one coming to Florida which was the forerunner to our current welcome stations.
