Address to the Keeper of the LOG, name of nominee, address, phone nos, email, spouse, etc. Give a brief summary of Jaycee Career (note: ones credentials for consideration for admission to the CREW of the SS Fellowship are based primarily on ones Jaycee Career and very little to do with ones JCI Senate Career) and dates including National, State, and Local Chapter Offices held, awards, etc. Post Jaycee Career including JCI Senate, Jaycee Foundations and Alumni Groups such as Corps, etc. Name of Nominator, Signature of Nominator and Date signed by the nominator. The CREW nominator should make a check payable to "The CREW of the SS Fellowship" (for an amount of \$100 or more but may consider less), which accompanies the nomination of a new Mate to the CREW. This has been customary since the inception of The CREW of the SS Fellowship. NOTE: Remember one cannot buy ones way into the CREW of the SS Fellowship and must be nominated by a current Mate, the accompanying check must be from the nominator for an amount of \$100 or more but will consider less and signed by the nominator, not the nominee.
